Requirements for Every Camp Staff Member:

- ✓ Born Again Believer
- ✓ Strong Relationship with God
- ✓ Watch for and take advantage of God-appointed opportunities to speak to children about their walk with God. Set an example for them in responding to Camp's challenges in a way that would please God.
- ✓ Align to CEF's Statement of Faith
- ✓ A Heart for Children

Counselor:

Requirements:

- ✓ Must be at least 13 years old
- ✓ A desire to encourage children in their walk with God

Responsibilities:

- Assigned 10-15 campers.
- Good Management of Camp Schedule. Be punctual in arriving at activities!
- Listen to Campers daily memory verses and extra verses.
- Enforce Camp rules. During the large group times, help campers be quiet and listen respectfully.
- Participate in activities alongside Campers
- Be able to simply share the gospel and counsel a child
- Dependable for the whole week; able to arrive on time!
- Have fun! And help your campers have fun!

Hours: Camp Staff Training - 2 hours; Week of Camp - 8am-5:15pm daily

Crafts Leader:

Requirements:

- ✓ Must be at least 20 years old
- ✓ A passion for arts and crafts

Responsibilities:

- Research themed crafts, choosing age-appropriate activities
- Present ideas to Camp Director for approval. CEF office will purchase supplies or reimburse upon approval.
- Help recruit crafts helpers
- Coordinate craft helper's participation
- Prepare daily crafts
- Direct children in how to complete their craft

Hours: Preparation - 20+ hours; Week of Camp – 2:30-4:45pm daily

Games Leader:

Requirements:

- ✓ Must be at least 20 years old
- ✓ A passion for recreation

Responsibilities:

- Research themed games, choosing age-appropriate activities. Game ideas are available from the CEF office. Game supplies are also available.
- Present ideas to Camp Director for approval.
- Acquire necessary game supplies (reimbursed upon Director's approval)
- Help recruit Games helpers
- Coordinate and supervise Games helpers
- Prepare daily games
- Direct children in how to play games, follow the rules, and promote safe practices

Hours: Preparation - 15+ hours; Week of Camp – 9:30am-12pm daily

Bible Teacher:

Requirements:

- ✓ Must be at least 21 years old
- ✓ A passion for teaching God's Word
- ✓ TCE1, CYIA level 4 and up, or equivalent training

Responsibilities:

- Prepare Bible Lessons from the provided curriculum for each day of Camp
- Clearly present God's Word and the Gospel to the children
- Apply the lesson to the Saved and Unsaved child, giving an opportunity for response

Hours: Preparation - 20+ hours; Week of Camp – 9:30am-12pm daily

Missions Teacher:

Requirements:

- ✓ Must be at least 15 years old
- ✓ A passion for missions
- ✓ TCE1 or equivalent training (CYIA Level 2 or up)

Responsibilities:

- Prepare Mission Lessons from the provided curriculum for each day of Camp
- Clearly present Missionary story, Missions Info, and at least one song to the children
- Include a challenge to the saved child on at least one day
- Be prepared to counsel children who feel called to missions

Hours: Preparation - 15+ hours; Week of Camp – 12:40-1:50, 3:35-4:30 daily

Crafts Helper:

Requirements:

- ✓ Must be at least 13 years old
- ✓ A passion for arts and crafts

Responsibilities:

- Help prepare daily crafts alongside Crafts Leader
- Listen to Leaders directives and help children do the same
- Aid children as they complete their crafts

Hours: Preparation – 0-5 hours; Week of Camp – 2:30-4:45pm daily

Games Helper:

Requirements:

- ✓ Must be at least 13 years old
- ✓ A passion for recreation

Responsibilities:

- Help prepare daily games alongside Games Leader
- Listen to Leaders directives and help children do the same
- Aid children during games time

Hours: Preparation – 0-5 hours; Week of Camp – 9:30am-12pm daily

Office/Nurse:

Requirements:

- ✓ Must be at least 20 years old
- ✓ Initiative to aid others
- ✓ Organizational skills!
- ✓ Computer/Office knowledge preferred
- ✓ First Aid Trained

Responsibilities:

- Keep office organized
- Be prepared to help other staff as needed
- Provide First Aid care for campers and staff
- Oversee administration of medications to campers
- Call to confirm absentees

Hours: Preparation – 0-5 hours; Week of Camp – Whole or half day

Other Staff Positions:

Snacks Coordinator

- Coordinates the preparation and serving of snacks
- Arrive at least 30 minutes prior to snack time to prepare
- Snack is served at - Morning: 10:45-11:05am.
Afternoon: 2:55-3:10pm and 3:35-3:50pm

Snacks Helper

- Helps Snacks Coordinator prepare and serve snacks

Puppet Team Member

- Be able to read script and adlib when necessary
- Can speak in a loud voice; accent preferred (Australian, English, Grampa voice, etc)
- Learn how to properly “speak” with a puppet

“Camp Buddy”

- Adult volunteer exclusively paired 1:1 with a special needs child
